To qualify, the child must...

- Play any instrument or sing (duets and trios also accepted)
- Memorize any piece of their choice (**2 minute maximum**)
- Finish grade K-11 by June 30, 2011
- Reside in Lake, Porter, LaPorte, Jasper, Newton or Starke Counties or study with teachers in the above counties or be a member of the Northwest Indiana Symphony Youth Orchestra
- Must provide their own accompanist for auditions
- Winners must provide their own Symphony-approved accompanist at the concert
- Contestant must not be a winner in 2009-2010 or 2010-2011 seasons

Winners will perform their piece at a classical, pops, education, outreach or summer concert within 18 months following the competition. These assignments are at the discretion of the music director.

Auditions will be held May 6 & 7, 2011
